**A. ENTRY DEADLINE**

All entries must be postmarked no later than August 1, 2008

**B. ELIGIBILITY**

1. Applicant **MUST** be a permanent Western New York resident attending a New York State school or a New York State resident attending a Western New York School. For purposes of this scholarship award, Western New York is defined as west of Interstate 81.
2. Applicant **MUST** be a US citizen or documented permanent resident of the United States.
3. At the time of the application deadline, applicant **MUST** have completed the first year of a two, four or five year degree program.
4. Applicant **MUST** be intent on pursuing a Bachelors or Associates Degree in a field related to bridge construction or design. A dual degree with construction and/or civil engineering as one part is acceptable. Student **MUST** be enrolled full-time, as defined by the school. Part-time students are not eligible for this scholarship award.

  - e. Two evaluation forms completed by others not related to the applicant.

## ABCD Scholarship Rules (Con't)

### **D. AWARDS**

1. Scholarship will be awarded for use in school expenses only. Awards will be sent directly to recipient's school.
2. Applications will be reviewed and award winners will be determined by the Scholarship Committee of the Association for Bridge Construction and Design, Western New York Chapter. Scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1,000. The ABCD Selection Committee will determine the number of scholarships awarded.
3. Factors which will be considered by the selection committee in determination of award winners are as follows, in decreasing importance: **Scholastic Performance; A Bridge Related Written Essay; Extra Curricular Activities/Employment; Evaluator Sheets and completeness and appearance of application.**
4. Award Winners will be notified in August, 2008.
5. One half of the scholarship award will be sent to the recipient's school in the fall 2008 school term. Upon receipt of continued student enrollment, the balance of the scholarship award will be sent to the recipient's school in the spring 2009 school term.
6. The recipient and their immediate family will be invited as guests of the ABCD at their Fall Conference, held in Buffalo, New York in November. A presentation will be made to the recipient during the conference.
7. Recipient is encouraged to actively seek summer internship in bridge construction/design or related field during undergraduate enrollment.
8. Recipient is required to submit semester grades to verify continued passing grade point average. Failure to do so could result in loss of award.
9. Recipient is required to study at the same school for the 2008-2009 academic year. Awards will not be transferred between schools if the recipient transfers.
